




6.2 MILLION Patient Visits - 1.8 MILLION Unduplicated Patients 624,000 New Patients in 2021 - 1,400 Clinics/Pharmacies 133,000 Volunteers (including 60,000 medical) - 12,600 Staff

- 68% of organizations reported seeing an increase in patients inquiring about care in the past year
- Before the COVID-19 pandemic, there were 200,000+ volunteers; with increased patient demand, volunteers are needed.
- 69% of clinics/pharmacies have an operating budget of \$500,000 or less
- 14% of organizations have a mobile unit to provide care
- · 83% of organizations use an EHR/EMR System
- 47% of organizations have an on-site pharmacy/dispensary
- 72% of organizations screen patients for social determinants of health
